

February 2025 Legislative Report Vice President Janice Broussard

Time for some background information for the legislature mechanics.

First the speaker is the presiding officer of the House of Representatives. Chosen from the representatives from among its members for each new legislative session.

The speaker is charged with maintaining order during floor debate, recognizing members to speak and ruling on procedural matters. As required by the constitution, the speaker is required to sign all passed bills and resolutions and may vote on all questions before the house.

The House Rules of Procedure, as adopted by the majority of the house members at the beginning of the session, determines any other duties and responsibilities of the speaker. Subject to seniority rules, the speaker appoints membership, chair and vice chair to the standing committees. The speaker also appoints conference committees, creates select committees and nonsession interim studies. The speaker refers all proposed legislation to committee.

The speaker is a formidable force in the house but in a committee the chair rules. The chair presides at the committee meetings and controls deliberations and activities, schedules committees, determines the necessity of public hearings and postings and appoints all subcommittees.

New operating rules for the house include a provision prohibiting minority party chairmanships but the standing committee vice chairs are reserved for members of the minority party. Under the drafted rules, chairs will "affirm" the vice chair's input on hearings, agendas for those hearings and invited witnesses for those hearings.

Next month we will explore some of the relevant bills and their status.


Galveston County is getting it's own Sex Trafficking Program

Today there are an estimated 79,000 youth and minor victims of sex trafficking in the state of Texas alone. Human trafficking occurs **any time a person is forced, tricked, or manipulated into providing labor or sexual services for someone else's financial gain.** Human trafficking can include forced labor, domestic servitude, organ trafficking, debt bondage, and/or sex trafficking and forced prostitution.



Kerri Taylor founded 'Unbound Now' which has expanded into Brazoria, Galveston, Fort Bend Counties and works with Austin and College Station. Friday Jan 31, at the Galveston Court house, many community groups came together to announce that Galveston County now has its own Unbound unit, which will be called 'Care Coordination,' under the direction of John Lee.

Unbound Now works and trains the police departments in Galveston County, the Sheriff's department and even TABC, who often go into bars to check on liquor compliance and report suspected sex trafficking.



Once notified, 'Care Coordinator' sends out one of their trained advocates, to stay with victims, escort them to forensic unit at UTMB if needed, help with safe housing, clothing and many aspects of care.

The Early Intervention Specialist will meet with the identified youth to build rapport, determine goals, and set up a service plan, utilizing the Casey Life Skills Assessment Tool.

Galveston Resource Crisis Center Staff provide lectures to church and social groups but are not allowed in our schools.

FBI Special Agents have emphasized the disturbing trend of parents trafficking their own children for drugs. Often these are the parents who will not allow discussion of the subject in schools. Traffickers often use their own homes or cheap motels for these acts, driven by the need to fund their drug habits.
